

NOTIFICATION

Tribal Research and Training Institute (TRTI) an extended arm of Tribal Development Department Govt. of Maharashtra for capacity building and research projects. This is targeted at Scheduled Tribe (ST) category youth is inviting the proposals from Non- Governmental Organizations (NGOs), corporate entities and Autonomous institutes and dedicated experts in this field. The project is for imparting entrepreneurship and skill development training as per the objectives and policy framework indicated in Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Policy (ESDP-2015) and Common Norms Committee Guidelines issued by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Govt. of India.

The Skill Development training may include the industrial sectors with high growth potential as identified by Union Govt. in Make in India program. These will be regular skill development training projects targeted at Scheduled Tribe category youth in the age group of 18-35 years with no bar on poverty status of tribal family.

The organizations in entrepreneurship and skill training having updated database of regional level manpower demand for various skills, based on existing and upcoming mega industrial projects can also submit the proposals with executed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for 100% placement guaranteed by corporate partner. These Institutes may be required to submit the reports on regional level skill gap studies or letter of intent by corporate partner in placement to absorb 100% trained tribal youth. The customized skilling intervention for such tie-up may or may not deviate from abovementioned policies and common norms.

TRTI is especially encouraging all organizations working for income generation and enhancement of tribal families to submit innovative training proposals which may involve building entrepreneurial capacities of tribal youth for value addition in the Minor Forest Produce (MFP) and promote micro enterprises. The Institutions with exposure to latest technology and association with national level research and development laboratories under Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) in promoting and disseminating indigenous technology and impact standard of living of tribal communities can also submit the proposals.

METHODOLOGY:

As receiving proposals, scrutiny thereof and sanctioning would be a continuous activity throughout the year, following methodology would be adopted.

1. Receipt and acknowledgement of Entrepreneurship and Skill Development (ESDP) proposals by TRTI, Pune
2. Primary scrutiny and empanelment on the website of TRTI as per empanelment policy indicating eligibility criteria etc.
3. Presentations by empaneled agencies on proposals before Sub-Committee of TRTI
4. Appraisal of the training proposal by sub-committee and recommendation for physical, financial sanction with coverage of TSP, ATSP, MADA etc. tribal pockets.
5. Approval of project by Commissioner, TRTI Pune.

Hard copies of Proposals are to be sent to the Office of TRTI on or before 30 June 2018.


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
