Submission of a proposal in response to this notice shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of this document with full under standing of its terms, conditions and implications.

## Section- 3: Instructions to Bidders

## 1. Background of TRTI

TRTI (TRTI), Pune is an Autonomous Institute of Tribal Development Department; Government of Maharashtra. The purpose of this project is to develop and deploy a publicly accessible WebGIS platform to support effective implementation, monitoring, and transparency in the recognition of Community Forest Resource (CFR) rights across Maharashtra. The platform will provide comprehensive spatial visualization of:

- 1. Villages with potential for CFR recognition,
- 2. Geographical areas with potential for CFR recognition,
- 3. Villages with CFR rights already recognized, including relevant title information, and
- 4. Tentative CFR boundaries for the CFR Management Activities, with downloadable Map Information for CFR Management Planning.
- 5. Provision to display IFR recognized areas, using GPS-based boundaries of IFR titles as they become available, through an authorized data manager
- 6. These datasets will be integrated with the following spatial reference layers to enable ease of use and field-level validation:
  - 6.1. High-resolution satellite imagery to facilitate identification of ground features,
  - 6.2. Village revenue boundaries,
  - 6.3. Forest compartment boundaries, and
  - 6.4. Administrative boundaries at the Taluka and District levels.

The WebGIS platform will serve as a dynamic, user-friendly tool for government agencies, civil society organizations, and local communities to access and utilize updated CFR-related spatial data in a transparent and participatory manner.

## 2. Objectives

- Identify CFR Potential Villages using spatial layers and census-linked forest land presence.
- Map CFR Potential Areas within and beyond village boundaries using GIS techniques and the 2 km Reserve Forest thumb rule.
- Incorporate Recognized CFR Rights and Titles for transparency and tracking.
- Map The CFR recognised Areas for better planned CFR Management.
- Provide an intuitive, mobile-friendly webGIS interface with search, measurement, upload, download.

#### 3. Scope of Work

- 1. Prepare methodology for estimating the potential areas of community forest rights based on village, forest and census data
- 2. Prepare methodology for identifying CFR recognized revenue survey plots and forest compartments based on CFR title data
- 3. Process and integrate spatial datasets:
  - i. Revenue village, taluka and district boundaries
  - ii. Forest compartment and revenue parcel boundaries
  - iii. CFR Potential Villages and Areas
  - iv. Census-tagged list of recognized CFR villages
  - v. CFR Recognized Areas as per CFR title using the Cadastral Layer.

4. Develop and deploy a webGIS interfage on the TRTI's server in English & Marathi to display the

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above layers, along with base satellite imagery, taluka and district boundaries, and Functionality to add new layers or layer group (e.g. land use pattern, Cadastral Map layer, water body Layer Etc.) to the dashboard, measurement tools, map/maps downloading feature (KML, PDF or Any Relevant feasible formats).

5. Build capacity: train TRTI staff for data upload, maintenance, and troubleshooting of the WebGIS interface

6. Maintain the platform for 12 months post-deployment

#### 3. Bid Process

The Bidder has to submit a Bid online in two envelope systems, one containing Technical Bid and other containing Commercial Bid for "Development of We-GIS portal for Display of Potential and Actually Recognized FRA areas (IFR/CFR) and Preparation of FRA atlas".

The Bidder can submit Bid for Online coaching, provided that the Bidder can arrange adequate resources within 7 days of award of contract, to provide coaching at the locations for which the Bid is submitted. Failure to arrange the resources, within 7 days, the award of the contract will be cancelled and the EMD will be forfeited.

## 4. Tender Fee(Non-Refundable)

The Bidders are requested to deposit the **Tender Fee of Rs.5,000**/-Online Proof of the same should be attached with the Technical Bid. It is to be noted that the Tender Fee is non-refundable. However, Tender Fee will be refunded in case of cancellation of overall tender process (i.e,if the tender process is can celled by TRTI.

#### 5. Earnest Money Deposit

The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 1,00,000/-is required to be deposited Online. Proof of the same should be attached with the Technical Bid.

- A. The EMD shall be denominated in Indian Rupees only.
- B. No interest will be payable to the Bidder on the amount of the EMD.
- C. Bids submitted without adequate EMD is liable for rejection.
- D. EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be refunded after completion of Bid process. EMD shall be non-transferable.
- E. The EMD may be forfeited:
- i. If a Bidder withdraws his Bid or revises/ increases his quoted prices during the period of Bid validity or its extended period, if any.
- ii. If successful Bidder fails to sign the Contract within the time specified by TRTI.
- iii. If during the Bid process, a Bidder indulges in deliberate act that would jeopardize or unnecessarily delay the process of Bid evaluation and finalization. The decision of the TRTI regarding forfeiture of the Bid Security shall be final and binding upon Bidders.

### 6. Transfer of Bid

The Bid / RFP Document are not transferable. The Bidder who purchases the Bid Document and submits the Bid shall be the same.

### 7. Consortium and Joint Ventures

Bids of joint venture/consortium/subcontracting will not be accepted.

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### 8. Completeness of Response

- a) Bidders are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms, requirements and other information in the Bid Documents carefully. Submission of Bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the Bid Document with full understanding of its implications.
- b) The response to this RFP should be full and complete in all respects. Failure to furnish all information required by the RFP document or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the RFP document will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of their Proposal.

### 9. Place of opening of RFP

The RFP will be opened in the Office of Tribal Research And Training Institute, 28Queens Garden, Pune -411001onthescheduled dates.

### 10. Bid Preparation Costs

The Bidder shall submit the Bid at its cost and TRTI shall not be held responsible for any cost incurred by the Bidder. Submission of a Bid does not entitle the Bidder to claim any cost and rights over TRTI and TRTI shall be at liberty to cancel or modify any or all Bids without giving any reason thereof.

All materials submitted by the Bidder shall be the absolute property of TRTI and no copyright /patent etc. shall be entertained by TRTI.

#### 11. Amendment of RFP Document

- a) If TRTI deems it appropriate to revise any part of this RFP or to issue additional data to clarify an interpretation of provisions of this RFP, it may issue supplements to this RFP. Any such corrigendum shall be deemed to be incorporated by this reference into this RFP.
- b) All the amendments made in the document would be published on the website of Government of Maharashtra https://mahatenders.gov.inand also on TRTI website <a href="https://trti.maharashtra.gov.in">https://trti.maharashtra.gov.in</a> and shall be part of the document.
- c) The Bidders are advised to visit the aforementioned website on regular basis for checking latest updates of this RFP document. TRTI also reserves the rights to amend the dates mentioned in this RFP for successful Bid process.

## 12. Pre- Bid Meeting

Pre-Bid meeting is open to all prospective Bidders. The same will be held on 06/11/2025 at 12:00 hrs., in the Office of Tribal Research and Training Institute, 28 Queens Garden, Pune -411001.

#### 13. TRTI's Right to Terminate the Process

TRTI may terminate the RFP process at any time and without assigning any reason. TRTI shall not be held responsible for any cost incurred by the Bidder in Bid preparation. TRTI reserves the right to amend/edit/add or delete any clause of this Bid Document. However, this will be informed to all and will become part of the Bid.

#### 14. Language of Bids

This Bid should be submitted in English language only. If any supporting documents submitted are originally in Marathior Hindi language, then that will be accepted as it is.



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#### 15. Bid Submission Format

The entire proposal shall be submitted strictly as per the format specified in this Bid Document. Bids with deviation from this format are liable for rejection.

#### 16. Submission of Bids

The Bidder should submit the Bid Online, which shall comprise of the following two envelopes

(Two envelope systems shall be followed for the Bid):

- A. Technical Bid (Proposal). Including relevant credentials
- B. Commercial Bid (Proposal).

### 17. Technical Bid

The Technical Bid should consist of all details, save and except the price as per Annexure- I. Technical Bid should be clearly super scribed as "Development of WebGIS portal for Display of Potential and Actually Recognized FRA areas (IFR/CFR) and Preparation of FRA atlas."

## a) Pre-qualification Requirements of the Institute/ Agency is as under:

- Must be a Registered legal entity in India.
- Must have Minimum 3 years of experience in GIS-based projects.
- Must have at least 1 completed Forest related WebGIS/spatial visualization projects.
- Must have a Qualified technical team (FRA expert, GIS expert).
- Must have a Minimum average annual turnover of ₹5 crore (₹1 crore for NGOs)
- Must have a Valid PAN and GST registration.
- Must have a Declaration of not being blacklisted.

## b) Desirable/ preferred qualifications

- i. Is a MoTA recommended Institute/ Agency for CFR potential mapping.
- ii. The Institute/ Agency should have a published methodology for CFR potential estimation.
- iii. The Institute/ Agency should have minimum 15 years of experience in the field of Forest Rights Act.
- iv. The Institute/ Agency or its personnel should have demonstrated policy engagement in Forest Rights Act, such as serving on Central and State committees related specifically to the Forest Rights Act.
- v. Have completed at least 1 project for a state or central government entity in the field of webGIS,
- vi. Have completed at least 1 project at District/ State/ National level on webGIS portal development for Community Forests Resource rights.

## c) Mandatory Documents to be uploaded with Technical Bid (Envelope No. 1)

- ix. Self-declaration for not black listed by any of the Govt. /Semi Govt. Organization.
- x. Self-declaration for not having criminal case against any Governing member / Partner/Director.
- xi. Team Composition and CVs of Key Personnel. (FRA experts, GIS Expert)
- xii. Detailed Technical Proposal (approach, methodology, work plan, etc.)
- xiii. Organizational Profile and Relevant Experience.
- xiv. Authorization Letter for the person signing and submitting the proposal.

Note: The Commercial Bid will be opened only after the opening and scrutiny of the Technical Bid.

The Commercial Bids of only those Bidders will be opened whose Technical Bids are qualified.

#### 18. Commercial Bid:

The Commercial Bid need to be submitted in BoQ format ONLY.

### 19. Disqualification:

The Bidder should ensure that all the required documents, as mentioned in this RFP / Bidding Document, are submitted along with the Bid. Non submission of the required documents may lead to the rejections of the Bid submitted by the Bidder. Besides other conditions and terms highlighted in the tender document, Bids may be rejected / disqualified under following circumstances:

- In case the Bidder fails to meet the Bidding requirements as indicated in this Bid /RFP or not submitted the Bid in accordance with the procedure and formats prescribed in this document.
- During validity of the Bid, or its extended period, if any, the Bidder increases his quoted price.
- Incomplete Bid or failure to furnish all information required as per tender document and failure to furnish proofs for information provided.
- Bid is received after due date and time.
- Bid is not accompanied by all the requisite documents.
- Bids submitted without or with improper EMD
- Bids without signature of person (s) duly authorized on required pages of the Bid.
- Bids without power of authorization and any other document consisting of adequate proof of the ability of the signatory to bind the Bidder.
- If the information provided by the Bidder is found to be incorrect / misleading at any stage / time during the Tendering Process.
- Technical Bid containing commercial details or revelation of prices in any form or by any reason beforeopening the Commercial Bid.

- Commercial Bids that do not conform to the Tender's Commercial Bid format (Annexure- II).
- The Bidder not conforming to unconditional acceptance of full responsibility of providing services inaccordance with the Agreements of this tender.
- If the Bid does not conform to the timelines indicated in the Bid.
- If the purchaser of the Bid (i.e., who pay Tender Fee and EMD) and submitter of the Bid is different.
- Any effort on the part of a Bidder to influence the Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or contract award decisions by unlawful/corrupt/fraudulent means at any point of time during the Bid process.
- Bidder fails to enter into a Contract within 10 Days of the date of issue of Letter of Selection / Award of Contract or within such extended period, as may be specified by the TRTI.
- While evaluating the proposals (Bids), if it comes to the knowledge of TRTI, expressly or implied, thatsome Bidders may have colluded in any manner whatsoever or otherwise joined to form an alliance resulting in delaying the processing of proposal, then the Bidders so involved are liable to be disqualified for this contract as well as for a further period of three years from participation in any of the RFP floatedby the TRTI.
- Bidder doesn't agree to the any one or more Terms and Conditions of the Bid.

## 20. Opening of Bid

- a) Envelope No. 1 containing the Technical Bid shall be opened Online in the office of TRTI, in the presence of the Bidder/ representatives of Bidder who choose to attend, at the address, date and time specified in the RFP.
- b) Envelope No. 2 containing Commercial Bid of the Bidders, who have qualified in the Technical Bid, shall only be opened, in the office of TRTI, in the presence of the Bidder/ representatives of Bidder who choose to attend, at the address, date and time specified in the RFP.

## 21. Evaluation of Technical and Commercial Bid:

Bid Evaluation Committee formed by Commissioner, TRTI will evaluate the Technical and Commercial Bid and submit its recommendation to Commissioner, TRTI. Decision of the Commissioner, TRTI would be final and binding upon all the Bidders.

#### A. Evaluation of Technical Bid

The evaluation of the Technical Bid will be carried out in the following manner:

- i. The Bidder's Technical Bid will be evaluated as per the requirements and evaluation criteria as mentioned in this Bid Document. The Bidders are required to submit all required documentation in support of the evaluation criteria.
- ii. At any time during the Bid evaluation process, the Committee may seek written clarifications from the Bidders. The Committee may seek inputs from their professional and technical experts in the evaluation process.
- iii. The Committee reserves the right to do a reference check of the past experience stated by the Bidder. Any feedback received during the reference check shall be taken into account during the Technical evaluation process.
- iv. The technical scores of the Bidders will be announced prior to the opening of the Commercial Bid.
- v. The Commercial Bid will be opened only after the opening and scrutiny of the Technical Bid.



The minimum qualifying marks required in technical criteria is 70 Marks (i.e., 70 %). The Bidders who score minimum 70 Marks shall be considered for Commercial Bid evaluation. The Bidders who do not score minimum qualifying marks of 70 %, their Bids shall be rejected and will not be considered for Commercial Bid evaluation. Total number of score should be equivalent to 100.

## Selection Method: Quality Cost Based System (QCBS)

The Bidder criteria for awarding the contract will be calculated based on the QCBS methodology. The weightage of Technical Score to Financial Score would be in the ration of 80: 20. Kindly refer the illustration below for understanding of the evaluation process

## **ILLUSTRATION**

The following is the procedure for evaluation for the award of tender:

The technical and financial scores secured by each bidder will be added with weight of 80:20 respectively Cumulative Bid Score arrived at, using the formula:

CS = TS \* 0.8 + FS \* 0.2

Where;

CTFS is Combined Technical and Financial Score;

TS = Technical bid Score:

FS = Financial bid Score

The bidder with highest Combined Technical and Financial Score (CTFS) will be the successful bidder and be eligible to become the service provider

Stage 2: Conversion of Financial Bid Amount to Score (FS)

## 22. Award of contract

Bid Evaluation Committee formed by Commissioner, TRTI will evaluate the Commercial Bid and Technical Bid as stated above, and submit its recommendation to Commissioner, TRTI. TRTI may empanel one or more eligible Bidder or cancel the Bid on the basis of their composite score and recommendation of the Bid Evaluation Committee. Decision of the Commissioner, TRTI would befinal and binding upon all the Bidders. TRTI will notify the acceptance of Bid to the successful Bidder.

## 23. Signing of Contract
